Under this agreement for 2017 Maleny State High School will receive

\$257,700*

This funding will be used to

- Increase Queensland Certificate of Education attainment from 93% up to 100%.
- Improve Reading results in NAPLAN to be above National Minimum Standards.
- Improve our subject pass rates to 80 - 85%.
- Train an additional 10 staff in 'Reading to Learn' strategies.
- Introduce 'New Pedagogies for Deep Learning' by trialing 2 -4 projects within the school.

Our initiatives include

- Continuation of 'Reading to Learn' as a strategy to improve Reading and Writing targeting specifically junior students.
- Introduction of additional pedagogies: 'Gradual Release' and 'New Pedagogy for Deep Learning'. These pedagogies aim to improve curriculum delivery.
- New Pedagogy for Deep Learning is targeted to improve our Upper 2 Bands.
- Increase the number and variety of Vocational Education Training options, entering into partnership with different Registered Training Organisations.
