

Uniform Policy Guidelines for the Uniform

While students are in uniform they are a representative of the school and appropriate positive behaviour is expected. Parent are asked to support the school by ensuring that their child/ren is/are appropriately dressed for school.

APPROVED UNIFORM ITEMS

SUMMER

- Formal blouse or formal shirt. These items are to be worn on excursions and when representing the school.
- Unisex polo shirt. This item can be worn on any day or for sporting activities.
- Long formal navy skirt or navy shorts. Shorts and skirts must be longer the 2/3 down the inner thigh. This is to ensure that skirts and shorts are of a suitable length that is appropriate to the school environment.

WINTER

- Navy, black, or skin coloured stockings or navy long pants.
- Unisex navy track pants, plain with no markings.
- Dark navy blue denim jeans with no rips or holes. Students must change into track pants or sports shorts for Physical Education classes or sport.
- Navy jumpers must be plain blue with no logos, markings etc.

GENERAL

- Hats that satisfy the "Sunsafe Policy for High Schools" will be part of the uniform. These hats should be worn in the sun.
- Closed in shoes should be worn at all times as per Workplace Health and Safety requirements. Black shoes should be worn with the formal uniform. Footwear should completely cover the foot.
- Make up should be minimal and practical. Only the following make-up will be allowed; Light foundation, chapstick, light eyeliner and mascara.
- School uniforms must be worn appropriately and respectfully. Underwear and midriffs must be covered at all times. (i.e. underwear and midriffs should not be visible)
- Skorts, skirts, shorts, trousers, track pants, hats, jumpers, and accessories (e.g. beanies gloves, scarves etc.) are to be plain navy blue with no markings/additional colours.

NON-APPROVED UNIFORM ITEMS

- Denim shorts, black jeans, jeans with holes or tattered jeans.
- Fishnet or similar stockings. Stockings with holes of extensive ladders.
- Ballet flats, thongs and sandals must not be worn

JEWELLERY POLICY

Only discreet studs and sleepers will be allowed in the ears (no arrows, no large holes in ears). Only nose and ear studs/sleepers will be allowed (no rings in the nose or eyebrows). Excessive and inappropriate jewellery is a safety risk and contravenes Workplace Health and Safety guidelines. Bracelets, watches and signet rings are permitted, but staff may ask for these to be removed or taped over for practical activities. This is a Workplace Health and Safety requirement. If, on rare occasions, the correct uniform is not able to be worn, then an explanatory note is expected.
